Colon Campbell Esq. of Fredell-County, State of N.C. Carolina,
being very sick & weak in Body but of perfect mind & memory,
thanks be to God for the same, & calling to mind the mortality
of my Body, & knowing that it is appointed unto all men
to die, do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament, that is
to say, principally & first of all I give & recommend my Soul
into the hands of God that gave it & as concerning my Body
I recommend it to the Earth, to be Buried in a decent man-
ner at the discretion of my Executors, nothing doubting but
at the general Resurrection to obtain everlasting happiness
in the life to come through the merits of my blessed
Redeemer, Jesus Christ, and as touching such Worldly Estate
wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life,
I give devise & dispose of the same in manner & form follow-
ing that is to say in the first place I give & Bequeath
to my beloved Wife, Jane Campbell, all my Land
& movable property during her Widowhood then to
be sold & be equally divided between my Children, that
is to say Colin Campbell, Mary, Isble, Jane, Martha,
Catharine, Prissilla, Nancy, I likewise constitute make
& ordain my only & sole Executor of this my last Will
& Testament my Wife Jane, John Woodsides & I
do hereby disallow revoke & disannul all former Testa-
ments, Wills, Bequests, bequeaths & Executors by me made
before this time named, Willed & bequeathed, Ratify,
& confirming this & no other to be my last Will and
Testament. I witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
& seal this day & Year, ^{first} above written, Signed, sealed,
published, pronounced by
