I Robert Bratton sen^r, of York-District State of South Carolina; being old & frail but in perfect health of body, and of perfect mind and memory, thanking be given unto God; calling unto mind the Mortality of my body, and knowing, that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament,
That is to say principally and first of all, I give and recommend my soul into the hand of Almighty God that gave it, and my Body I commend to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial, at the discretion of my Executors; nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again, by the mighty power of God. And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give, devise, and dispose of the same in the following manner and form:

First - I give & bequeath to my beloved Son William Bratton two Dollars --

Secondly - I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter false Hamp hill two Dollars --

Thirdly - I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Ann Smidday two Dollars --

Sixthly - I give and bequeath to my beloved Son Robert Bratton; all and singularly the Plantation or tract of Land whereon I now live with my Negro Man May - Also My Waggons & two Horses, my whole Stock of Cattle and Hogs, my two Beds & furniture, together with all my Household & Kitchen furniture

and Plantation tools &c

And lastly I do constitute, make & ordain
my beloved Son Robert Bratton and my beloved
+ trusty friend James Simpson my only and
sole Executor, of this my last Will and Testament
and do hereby utterly disallow, revoke, and disannul
all and every other former, Testaments, Wills, Le-
gacies Bequeathings and Executors, by me in any
Ways before this, named, made & Bequeathed, sa-
lifying and confirming this, and no other to be
my last Will and Testament &c In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Seal, this 23rd Day of August in the

Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and fourteen
