PATRICK DUNCAN

In the Name of God amen I Patrick Duncan of Camden District in y^e Colloney of South Carolina Being through y^e abundant Mercy and Goodness of God of Sound Perfect understanding & Memory- Do make & ordain y^e my last will & Testament in manner & for in following.-----

My Will & Desire is y^e all Lawfull Debts & funeral charges be paid & Discharged by my Executors - herein after named.--

Item I will bequeath & Demise to my Son Thomas Duncan ascertain Tract of plantation containing one Hundred & Fifty acres Formarly Improved on by y^e sd Thomas Duncan and adjoining y^e Plantation on which I now live to him his heirs Exrs Admrs and assigns forever.-----

Item I will Bequeath & Demise to my Son James Duncan y^e Plantation or Tract of land on which I now live containing Two Hundred & one acres to him his heirs Exrs. Admrs. and Assigns forever. he y^e sd James Duncan paying to my Daughter Margret Duncan her heirs y^e full Sum of one Hundred Pounds Currancy at four Different paymts (Viz) y^e first payment of Twenty five pounds Currancy to be made to her one year & a Day after my Decease y^e Remainder at Twenty five pounds of Currancy per year till y^e Remaining Seventy five pounds of Currancy be paid

Item I will & Bequeath to my son Jn^o Duncan one Cow & calf

Item I will & Bequeath to each of my sons Viz. Robert Duncan Benjamin Duncan & William Duncan Five Shillings Sterling

Item I will & Bequeath to each of my Son in laws Viz. James Kerr, Jn^o Alexander, Jn^o Garvan James Luck Five Shellings Sterling ~~XXXXXXXX~~ Each

Item I will & bequeath to my Grand daughter Mary Garvan Twenty five pounds currancy

Item I will and ordan y^e all my Remaining Personal Estate be Sold at publick Vendue and y^e money thence arising after all my Debts & Legacies is paid y^e Remainder to be Equally Divided Between My Daughters Viz. Jean Kerr Mary Luck Rachel Alexander and my grand Daughter Violet Duncan Daughter to my Son Jn^o Duncan So y^e Each of y^e may have a Share & Share alike. Lastly I Contitute & ordain Jn^o Duncan & William Watson my Executors of y^e my last will & Testament & my Cous^o Chas Moore overseer of it be performed according to the true Intent & Meaning. And acknowledges this to be my last will & Testament. Revocking all former will & Testaments whatsoever Signed Seald & acknowledged this 20th Day of Octb 1776
