In the name of God Amen I Alexander, Lope of New Acquisition District and State of South Carolina being weak of Body but of sound memory and in my proper sense Do this Twentyeighth Day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty one Make This my Last will and Testament in form and manner following (viz) my soul I bequeath to god Who gave it and my Body to the Dust in hope of a happy Resurrection in due time shall be no more. Item I give and Bequeath unto my Son Andrew all that Tract or parcel of Land (Surveyed by Fra Adams) and which he is now in full possession of the same I give and Devise to him his heirs and assigns forever Likewise I Bequeath unto my Son James all that Tract or parcel of Land which is now in possession and which adjoins Lands of Michael McCarty the same I do Devise to him and his heirs and assigns forever and in case of Defaute of heirs of his Body Begotten then the same to be sold and the money there arising to be Equally Divided amongst my remaining sons and my daughter Elizabeth unless that my Son James hath Before his Decease made a Will which if he hath done then to Devise according to that Will Likewise I give and Bequeath unto my Son Andrew all that Tract or parcel of Land which he is now in possession of and which adjoins the Lands Devised to my Son Andrew and the Lands Devised to my Son James Likewise One hundred acres of the tract wheron Sonow live to Divide off on the side adjoining Samuel Currys and Alexander Clark and the same I do Devise to him his heirs and assigns forever and in case of Defaute of his heirs then to be sold and the money there arising to be Equally Divided amongst my remaining Sons and my daughter Elizabeth unless that my Son William hath first made a Will and then it is to Devise according to that Will Likewise I Bequeath unto my Sons Andrew James Alexander and William to be held in Equal Partnership by them their heirs and assigns forever and in case of Default in any of them of such heirs of their Body Begotten then to Devolve to the remaining Brethren unless that Before their or his Death they or he hath made a Will and then it is to Devise according to that Will All that Tract or parcel of land known by the name of the mines I do Devise as last above written Likewise I do Bequeath unto my loving wife Margaret one Negro Wench named Dinah During the Term of her natural life and then to Devolve to my son Andrew to him his heirs and assigns for ever Likewise I do Bequeath unto Margaret my wife During the Term of her natural life one Negro Wench named Hattie and at her death to Devolve to him his heirs and assigns forever And in Default of heirs of his Body Begotten then to Devolve to the remaining Sons and my daughter Elizabeth to be by them sold and the money thence arising Equally Divided amongst them Likewise I do Bequeath to my Son William one Negro Fellow named York Andrew Wench named Tom to him his heirs and assigns forever And in Default of heirs of his Body Begotten then to be sold and the money arising therefrom to be Equally Divided amongst the surviving Sons Brothers unless that the abovementioned Sons James or William either or both should make Wills and then they are to Devise according to such Wills Likewise I do Bequeath to my Son Alexander one Negro wench married to him his heirs and assigns forever and in Default of such heirs of his Body Begotten then to be sold and the money arising from such sale to be Equally Divided amongst my surviving Sons and my daughter Elizabeth unless that the P. Alexander hath first made a will and then she is to Devise according to P. Will Likewise I do Bequeath to my loving wife Margaret one Large Bay Pacing horse with a Star in his Face also a Paddle and all the Plenishing and Furniture in the house or any way Belonging to or pertaining therunto in whatsoever place it may be to be entirely Divided between my Sons James Alexander and William and my daughter Elizabeth at such time and in such manner as my wife shall think proper and also that my wife is to have her Choice of any room in the house for her Residence during her life so also my silver & plate During her life and at her decease my Paddle to Devolve to my son Alexander Likewise I do Bequeath my silver & plate to my Son William Likewise I do Bequeath my Black Servant mare to my Son Andrew his heirs and assigns forever the remainder of my Horse Creatures I do Bequeath to my Son William his heirs and assigns forever Likewise I do Bequeath to Margaret my wife her Choice of two Cows out of the whole flock and to order and sell the same to have a sufficient Maintenance for herself and her creatures off of the plantation wheron I now live During the Term of her life I do Bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Three Cows and Three Heifers also three Eves and three Weather roost to her her heirs and assigns forever the remainder of my Stock of cattle I do Bequeath to my Sons James Alexander and William in Equal parts to be divided to them their heirs and assigns for ever Likewise I do Bequeath my Harrow Hanes and Crostentlaw to my Sons their heirs and assigns forever and to order and appoint that whatever else Belongs to my Estate and is not mentioned in this my last will and Testament be Entirely at my wifes Disposal either to keep for her own use or Devise as she shall think proper and I do constitute and Appoint Maylone Andrew and James to be the Executors of this my last will and Testament in trust for the intent and purpose therin contained in witness whereof the said Alexander doth have his hand and Seal the day and year above written
