In the name of God Amen I Alexander Love of New Acquisition District and State of South Carolina being weak of
Body But of sound memory and in my proper senses Do this Twentieth Day of March in the year of our Lord One Thousand Se-
ven Hundred and Eighty one Make this my Last will and Testament in for a and manner following (Viz) my Soul I Be-
queath to god Who gave it and my Body to the Dust in hope of a happy Resurrection when time shall be no more
I Give and Bequeath unto my son Andrew all that Tractor parcel of Land (Surveyed By Grad Adams) and Which he
is now in full possession of the same I Give and Devise to him his heirs and assigns Forever Likewise I Bequeath un-
to my son James all that Tractor parcel of Land which is now in possession and which he joins Lands of Michael M^r
by the same I do Devise to him and his heirs and assigns Forever and in Case of Default of heirs of his Body Begot-
ten then the same to be sold and the money thence arising to be Equally Divided amongst my remaining sons and my Daughter
Elizabeth unless that my son James hath before his Decedence made a will Which if he hath done then to Devise according to
that will Likewise I Give and Bequeath unto my son Alexander all that Tractor parcel of Land which he is now in posses-
sion of and which joins the Lands Devise to my son Andrew and the Land Devise to my son James Likewise One hundred
Acres of the Tract Wheron I now live to be Divided off on the side adjoining Samuel Currys and Alexander Clark and the
same I do Devise to him his heirs and assigns Forever and in Case of Default of heirs of his Body Begotten then to
be sold and the money thence arising to be Equally Divided among my remaining sons and my Daughter Elizabeth
unless that I Alexander hath first made a will and then it is to Devise according to that will Likewise I Give
and Bequeath unto my son William all that Tractor parcel of Land Wheron I now live the same I do Devise to him his
heirs and assigns Forever and in Case of Default of heirs of his Body Begotten then to be sold and the money thence arising to be
Equally Divided amongst my remaining sons and my Daughter Elizabeth unless that I William hath first
made a will and then it is to Devise according to that will Likewise I Bequeath unto my sons Andrew James
Alexander and William to be held in Equal Partnership by them their heirs and assigns Forever and in Case of De-
fault in any of them of such heirs of their Body Begotten then to Devolve to the remaining Brethren unless that be-
fore their or his Death they or he hath made a will and then it is to Devise according to that will All that Tractor parcel
of Land known by the name of the mines I do Devise and last Above Written Likewise I do Bequeath unto my loving
Wife Margaret one Negro Wench named Dinah During the Term of her Natural life and then to Devolve to my son An-
drew to him his heirs and assigns for ever Likewise I do Bequeath unto Margaret my Wife During the Term of her
Natural life one Negro Wench named Thate and at her Death to Devolve to him his heirs and assigns Forever
And in Default of heirs of his Body Begotten then to Devolve to the remaining sons and my Daughter Elizabeth to be by
them sold and the money thence arising Equally Divided amongst them Likewise I Bequeath to my son William
one Negro fellow named York and one Wench named Jean to him his heirs and assigns Forever and in Default of heirs
of his Body Begotten then to be sold and the money arising therefrom to be Equally Divided amongst the surviving Bre-
thren unless that the above mentioned sons James or William either or Both should make wills and then they are to
Devolve according to such wills or wills Likewise I Bequeath unto my son Alexander one Negro wench named Chlo-
to him his heirs and assigns Forever and in Default of such heirs of his Body Begotten then to be sold and
the money arising from such sale to be Equally Divided amongst my surviving sons and my Daughter
Elizabeth unless that the I Alexander hath first made a will and then it is to Devolve according to that will
Likewise I Bequeath to my loving Wife Margaret one Large Bay Pacing horse with a Star in his Face also a Saddle and all the
Plenishing and Furniture in the house or any way belonging to or appertaining therunto in whatever place it may be
to be Equally Divided between my sons James Alexander and William and my Daughter Elizabeth at such time and in such por-
tion as Margaret my Wife shall think proper and also that Margaret my Wife is to have her Choice of any Room in the house for her
Residence during her life also my silver Buckles During her life and at her Decedence my Buckles to Devolve to my son Alexan-
der Likewise I Bequeath my silver Clasp to my son William Likewise I Bequeath my Opash velvet mare to my son Andrew
his heirs and assigns forever the Remainder of my Horse creatures I Bequeath to my son William his heirs and assigns Forever Likewise
I Bequeath to Margaret my Wife her Choice of two Cows out of the whole flock and I order and will that she have a sufficient Man-
tainance for herself and her creatures off of the plantation Wheron I now live During the Term of her life I do Bequeath
to my Daughter Elizabeth Three Cows and Three Hifers also three Ewes and three ~~sheep~~ ^{goats} to her her heirs and assigns
Forever the Remainder of my Stock of Cattle I Bequeath to my sons James Alexander and William in Equal parts to be de-
vise to them their heirs and assigns for ever Likewise I Bequeath my Harrow Flans and Crosscut saw to my four sons
their heirs and assigns Forever and I do order and Appoint that whatever else Belongs to my Estate and is not mentioned in this
my last will and Testament be Entirely at my Wife's Disposal either to keep for her own use or to give as she shall think
proper and I do constitute and Appoint Margaret Andrew and James to be sole Executors of this my last will and Tes-
tament in trust for the intent and purposes therein contained in witness whereof the said Alexander Love hath to this
my last will and Testament set my hand and seal the Day and year above written
