cow & steen calf & one sorrel horse Saddle and bridle  
I will that my Daughter Rachel Campbell one  
red cow whight on her back and her calf with  
son William shall have sorrel horse one bay stud  
Remainder of my cattle together with the  
Family and the sheep to be at Disposal of my  
Daughter in Kentucky have my saddle and  
possession of Crittoper Farmer to be Equally  
Sarah & the ten Dollars in the hands Samuel  
for Rachel Campbell I do hereby will and  
the plantation Whereon I now live to him  
and my wife Ann Campbell shall have a comfortable  
life of widowhood & I will that my son Robert  
by visiting in raising grain for the support of  
a single life and I do constitute and appoint  
executors of this my last will and Testament  
hand and Seal this twentieth day of August
