## WILL OF MOSES BIGGER STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

York District ) In the name of God Amen I Moses
Bigger of the State and district aforesaid being weak in body
but of perfect mind and memory thanks be to God for the same
calling to mind that it is appointed for all Men once to die
to make and ordain this to be my last will and Testament in
Manner and form as follows-----

Item 1st. I will and bequeath to my Brether James Bigger the track of Land I now live on with the exception of Forty Acres I purchased from William Moore forever----- Also my Cotton Ginn & Screw, & Thrasher I also give to him my young Gray Horse named Willington--

Item 2d. I will and bequeath to my Sister Mary Meagle the following Megroes to her and to the heirs of her body forever not to be subject to the payment of any debt or debts which have or may be contracted by her husband William Meagle My Negro Woman named Mariah about 25 years of age and her Children named as follows Sarah about seven or Eight years old Green Six or Seven Darcus Five Sue Three Minerva One year old which Megroes She has in possession now. Also a Note I have on William Meagle for Minety dollars with the Interest from the date slse one hundred Dollars worth of Cotton which William Meagle promised to pay to me. Also all of the House hold and kitchen furniture which She has in her possession consisting of Beads Tables one Cubboard one Beaurau tegether with too horses Five or Six head of Cattle Twenty six head of Neggs Five or Six head of Sheep now in her possession

Item 3d. I Will and bequeath to my Sister Elisabeth Patterson as follows My Negro Girl named Carolina about 12 years old forever

also a Note I hold on William Bigger of Four hundred Dollars with the Interest from the date----

Item 4th I will and bequeath to my Brother William M Bigger as follows My Megro Man named Buff about 35 years old foreger Also a Note I hold on himself to the amount of Six hundred Dollars with the exception of credits on the note----

Item 5th. I will and bequeath to my Nephew James Heagle son of William Meagle my Silber Watch;-----

Item 6th I Will and bequeath to my nephew Alexander B Biggar & James McKee Bigger Bon of Mathew, Forty Acres of land which I purchased from William Moore to be eqully divided between them forever Also to my Meaces Ann E Bigger & Martha E Bigger & my nephew Andrew Bigger Fifty dollars each----

Item 7th. I Will and bequeath to my Neace Amelia Neagle Daughter of William Neagle a Roan Mare Coalt about Six or Eight Months Old-----

Item 8th My Will is that all of my Stock consisting of Horses Cattle Hoggs & Sheep that have not been disposed of by me together with all my household & kitchen furniture Farming Utensills my toe Read Waggons Geer of every discription be sold and the Monies arising from Said Sale together with my Notes & Accounts which have not been bequeathed divided between my Brothers & Sisters equally after all my just debts are spid. My Will is that that part of it which goes to my Sister Mary Meagle be Kept by my Brother James Bigger and give to her as She may need it.

And I do constitute and appoint my Brother James Bigger my Sole
Executor of this my last Will and Testament and I do utterly
disannull all others Wills or Testaments by me made or any
other Exr. by me named but this Will only & Exr. by me named to
be my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 16th day of Nevember 1834
