3rd I allow my Son J E Feemster to have the Judgement that I hold on him the Judgement is in the Sheriff's Office at Yorkville

4th I allow my two Grand Children John W Howel and Robert Samuel Howel fifty dollars Each to be paid out of my Estate by my Executors when they become twenty one years old

5th I desire that the balance of my undivided property both real & personal to be Equally divided with out Sale amongst all of my Children as follows E C Feemster S M Feemster J E Feemster Margaret Love Hanna Dowdle & Nancy Dowdle to be theirs and their heirs forever
