I Pamphret Herndon Sen of the County of Franklin and State of Tennessee being in a low state of Body health though of perfect mind and memory do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament and followeth in the first place I commit my Soul to God who gave it me with the request that my body may be buried in a Christian like manner and as for what worldly effects it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I dispose of in the following manner.. Item I give unto my beloved Wife Patty Herndon during her natural life my Negro woman Mary and her increase and My Negro boy Allen and my Negro boy Nero Item ) I give unto my beloved Wife Patty Herndon during her natural life all my household and Kitchen furniture and all my farming Utensils and four cows and calves and her choice of one of my stock of horses and her choice of twelve of my stock of hogs and her choice of Six of my Stock of Sheep.. Item ) After the Death of my Wife Patty Herndon I give and bequeath to my Son Pamphret Herndon my negro Woman Mary and her increase and my negro boy Allen and my negro boy Nero to heir and his heirs forever Item ) I give unto my son Pamphret Herndon my Waggon and hired years to him and his heirs forever reserving the use hereof to my Wife Polly Herndon during her Natural life.. Item ) I give unto my Son Pamphret Herndon twelve head of sheep to him and his heirs forever.. Item ) I give unto my daughter Sally Kirkley my negro girl Lucy and my negro boy Nathan to her and her heirs forever.. Item I give unto my Daughter Jenny Burnett my negro woman Betty and my negro girl Charlot to her and her heirs forever.. Item ) I give unto my Daughter Patty King my negro boy George and my negro Girl Amy to her and her heirs forever.. Item ) I give unto my Daughter Polly Powell during her Natural life my negro boy Lewis and my Negro Girl Sooky.. Item I give unto my Daughter Polly Powell two cows and calves and one Two year old colt and two yews and lambs to her and her heirs forever.. Item After the death of my Daughter Polly Powell I give unto my three grand children (Viz) John A Powel, Walter F Powell and Louise Powell my negro boy Lewis and my negro girl Sooky to them and their heirs forever to be equally divided among them share and Share alike.. Item It is my request that my negro woman Molly serve my Wife Patty Herndon during her Natural life then to be Liberated and left to the care of my son Pamphret Herndon.. I give unto my Grand children the children of Walter Herndon deceased Seven Dollars to be equally divided among them share and share alike.. Item ) give unto my Grand children the children of Alexander Burnett deceased to be equally divided among them Seven Dollars share and share alike Item I give (p-35) unto my Son in law William Street One Dollar.. Item ) It is my request that all the Balance of my property not heretofore mentioned shall be sold and after paying all my just debts the proceeds thereof to be equally divided among my Grand children (Viz) the children of Joseph Hale deceased and great grand children the children of Patsy Parker deceased the said Children of Patsy deceased drawing one share to them and their heirs forever.. Item After the Death of my Wife Patty Herndon I give unto my Grand Children the children of Joseph Herndon deceased and my Great Grand Children the children of Patsy Parker deceased all the property left to my Wife Patty Herndon and not heretofore divided to be equally divided among them the children of Patsy Parker taking one share

to them and their heirs forever and lastly I appoint my Wife Patty Herndon and my son Pamphret Herndon my Executor and Executrix to carry into effect this my last Will and Testament.. In Witness whereof I have herunto set my hand and seal this 28 day of October in the year of our lord 1820

Item I commit my soul to an indulgent God my body I wish to be buried by my Executors on the place lately purchased by my son John C Tanner.. Item I lend to my Wife Nancy Tanner during her natural life or Widdowhood. Six Negroes towit 1 Caroline 1 Ruth Elizabeth Jesse Anne & Moses together with one large family Bible & one Gray horse.. Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Susan B Williams one Sellabulb glass Dorin Silver laddy spoons to her and her heirs forever--(m) I give and bequeath to my son John C Tanner one Rifle Gun One Silver Watch one set of Nicholsons Encyclopedia in 12 volumns & Marshals Life of Washington in 5 volumns to him and his heirs forever-- Item ) I give and bequeath to my Daughter Martha A Tanner one Gray mare one English cow and her increase Two sows and pigs four Ewes and lambs one Womand Saddle & Briddle One Beaureau and Dressing Table one bed & furniture and bedstead one set of Stamped Curtains two flowered pitchers half Dozen Blue plates four China plates one Red Tea Board one set of Dish mats one carpet together with all the books which have her name written in them to her and her heirs forever.. Item ) I lend to my Daughter Martha A Tanner four negro's towit Judith Joshua, Frances & Caleb and their (p-34) and at her death I give and bequeath the said four negroes and their increase to the children of the said Martha A Tanner of her body lawfully begotten but should the said Martha A Tanner die bearing no child as above then and in that case I give and bequeath the said four Negroes and their increase to be equally divided among the children of my Daughter Susan B Williams of her Body lawfully begotten to them and their heirs respectively forever. I give and bequeath to my grand son James Rust Williams one pocket pistol and at the death of my Wife Nancy Tanner I give the said James R Williams one Gray horse loaned her to him and his heirs forever Item 3 at the death or marriage of my Wife Nancy Tanner I give and bequeath to my son John C Tanner Caroline & Jesse but not their increase one large family Bible provided he should continue to live in Franklin County State of Tennessee as long as his Mother lives take care of her Item) at the death or marriage of my Wife Nancy Tanner I give and bequeath to my daughter Martha A Tanner one negro boy named Moses to her and her heirs forever.. Item ) After the death or marriage of my Wife Nancy Tanner I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Nancy C Williams one Negro Girl Ruth & her increase to her and her heirs forever Item) I also give to my Grand Daughter Judith Williams at the death or
