

We the undersigned whose names are hereunto affixed, being sworn on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty God do depose and say that we were personally present at the making and declaring of the following verbal noncapitive Will of Rebecca Bryant now deceased; that the said will was made on the 18th day of June 1825 in her own dwelling house, in the County of Wilson and State of Tennessee, where she had resided for several years previous to the making of the said noncapitive Will - We the deponents do certify that the said testatrix called upon and they were specially required to bear witness that the Will as herein after stated was her wish Will and Testament; and they furthermore believe that the said testatrix was of a sound disposing mind and in the proper exercise of her mental faculties.

Item first - I give and bequeath unto my youngest daughter Masey Bee Bryant sixty-five dollars in cash.

Item second - As my two eldest children have received a horse each, I wish all my other children to receive a horse each to make them all equal -

Item third - All the remainder of my estate I wish to be sold, and the money proceeding therefrom to be equally distributed among all of my children (viz. Hiram Bryant, Mary Bryant, Archibald Bryant, Lydia Bryant, Samuel Bryant, Julia Bryant & Masey B. Bryant) share and share alike -

And furthermore these deponents saith not.
