Almighty God do depose and say that we were per-
sonally present at the making and declaring of
the following verbal nuncupative Will of Rebecca

on the 18th day of June 1825 and
on the day of her last sickness, in her own dwelling
house, in the County of Wilson and State of Ten-
nessee, where she had resided for several years previous
to the making of the said nuncupative Will - We the
deponents do certify that the said testatrix called upon
and they were specially required to bear witness that
the Will as herein after stated was her wish Will and
testament; and they furthermore believe that the said
testatrix was of a sound disposing mind and in the
proper exercise of her mental faculties.

Item first - I give and bequeath unto my youngest
daughter Masey Bece Briant sixty-five dollars in cash.

Item second - As my two eldest children have received
a horse each, I wish all my other children to receive a horse
each to make them all equal -

Item third - All the remainder of my estate I wish to
be sold, and the money proceeding therefrom to be equal-
ly distributed among all of my children (viz. Thimam Bri-
ant, Mary Briant, Archibald Briant, Lytle Briant, Sam-
uel Briant, Julia Briant & Masey B. Briant) share and
share alike -
