 Estate of God of his mercy bestowed on me I do order Lett & Give & bequeath
 same in manner & form following
 I give and bequeath to my Loving Son Corin Jacob Savage my plantation houses
 garden & fence orchard ways & fountains & feeding Pastures being five hundred & thirty two
 acres of Land form by Lett to me & my two brothers as Thomas & John & William
 Savage by their Father Lett to me by his Last will & Testament may more att
 large make appear I give & bequeath to my Son Corin Jacob to him & his heirs lawfully
 begotten of his body & for want of such heirs to fall to his brother Abell Savage
 to him & his heirs lawfully begotten of his body & for want of such heirs to my
 brother William Savage this son Parker Savage & to his heirs for ever & if
 said Land I give to my Corin Abell Savage & he should dye without heirs then
 to returne againe to my Corin Jacob Savage & his heirs for ever. Item I give unto
 my Corin Abell Savage Eighty seven acres of Land I formerly bought of his
 brother John Savage to him & his heirs lawfully begotten of his body & for
 want of such heirs then to his Brother Jacob Savage & to his heirs lawfully
 begotten of his body & for want of such heirs then to Parker Savage & his
 heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath to my Corin Jacob Savage all my
 Turners Tools & all my weavers &ernes of what kind soever & my Pistols &
 holsters & one Gun & two small dishes & two puter plates & one small Iron
 Pott & one Father Bed & bolster and Covering to w. D. Bed & one Band Mill &
 one Great Table & one sword & my best Dress & bridle & saddle & all my
 Linnen & Cargue to him & his heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath to my
 Loving Son Sarah Nelson one feather Bed & bolster and white Covering
 belonging to her & her heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath to them if
 that brings a Key belonging to a Chest above Staires about 4 foot Long & what
 in it they that brings w. D. Key belonging to d. D. Chest may have it &
 what in it Lett it be w. D. Key soever to y^m and their heirs for ever. Item
 I give & bequeath to my God Daughter Susanna Kellom one likely heifer
 and a Good Cowe and their Increase to her & to her heirs for ever. Item I
 give & bequeath & bequeath unto Richard Savage Junior w. Son of Sarah
 Warrenton one feather Bed & bolster and Covering belonging to it and
 I desire if his mother Sarah Warrenton may keep w. D. Bed & Covering
 in her possession till he comes to age & then to delivered to him & his
 heirs for ever. Item I give to my Loving Brother William Savage my
 best sute of Apperrell to him & his heirs for ever. Item I give to my
 Loving Friend John Henderson my snare to him and one Iron pott
 to him & his heirs for ever. Item my will & desire is that w.
 remaining parte of my Estate after my debt & funeral Charges
 are paid & Legacies w. Remaining part of my Estate should be Equally
 Divided Between my Corin Jacob & Abell & John Savage & Sarah Nelson &
 Susannah Joyner to be Equally Divided between them of what kind soever
 where it may be found. Item I desire if w. Court may have nothing
 doe with my Estate to bring it to appraisement after my decease
 Item my will and desire is if my Corin Jacob Savage and John
 Henderson both may stand to be my sole and whole Executors of this
 my Last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have; subscribed
 hereunto Lett my hand this 7th day of May Anno Dom 1720.
